## **THE LIVESTOCK CENTRE: ADDING VALUE TO DUST AND CHIPS!**

Expressions of Interest will be sought in the new year for the provision of woodchips/sawdust for The Livestock Centre, Muchea that will be used for flooring for sheep and cattle respectively.

Midland Saleyard Relocation Chairman Malcolm Seymour said, "We see an opportunity to come to an arrangement with a garden supplier to harvest the manured product for commercial use".

"Muchea will be the first facility in Western Australia to adopt this technology. In the Eastern states, the manured soft flooring has proven to be a valuable by-product for the garden and horticultural industries" Mr Seymour said.
