## **STAGE 2 UNDERWAY AT MUCHEA**

The machinery started arriving last week in preparation for this weeks commencement of Stage Two Forward Works at the Muchea Livestock Centre.

Local contractor Yarnel has been awarded the tender which will take approximately 14 weeks at a cost of \$2.8million.

Midland Saleyard Relocation Chairman, Mr Malcolm Seymour said, "Stage 2 earthworks is the largest undertaking so far, involving the "cut and fill" of the 16ha site upon which the Saleyard pad will sit".

"In addition, the aerobic and anaerobic ponds will be dug as well as one clean water storage dam", Mr Seymour said.
